TREATMENT PROTOCOL

SKIN RASH

1. Symptoms/Presentation:

- Visible reddened patches or spots of any size/color.
- Complaints of itching

2. Obtain medical history:

- When did onset occur?
- Are there any known allergies to food, medications or materials?
- Does it come and go or is it constant?

3. Assess for shortness of breath, or coughing. May be an early sign of anaphylaxis.

4. If inmate is currently taking a new medication or antibiotic, notify Facility Nurse.

5. If not severe, have inmate fill out a Health Care Request Form.

6. If rash appears severe and/or there are other symptoms call Facility Nurse or Facility Provider.
