STANDING ORDER
SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTIONS

I. ASSESSMENT

- A. If inmate reports concern of STI, please refer to Dysuria SO-522 for guidance on obtaining history and for more information on management.

II. MANAGEMENT

- A. If inmate asymptomatic, but is concerned about exposure to an STI or requests for STI screening:
 - 1. Obtain dirty urine for GC/Chlamydia testing for males. For females, obtain a self-collected vaginal swab. Refer to information in lab cabinet for proper swabs.
- B. If inmate has any symptoms concerning for STI (refer to Dysuria SO-522)
 - 1. Schedule inmate to see Facility Provider at earliest availability to evaluate further.
- C. If test results are positive, check for allergies and then give the following based on test results:
 - 1. Positive Gonorrhea test – Ceftriaxone 250 mg IM stat x 1 dose AND Azithromycin 1 gm PO stat x 1 dose
 - 2. Positive Chlamydia test – Azithromycin 1 gm PO stat x 1 dose
- D. If inmate is allergic to the above treatments, call Facility Provider for orders
- E. Notify Public Health of positive test results
